EYLEM SENYUZ

Senior Vice President AT Truist Advisory Services

Eylem Senyuz is a senior vice president and senior investment strategy analyst at Truist Advisory Services, Inc. where he leverages his deep knowledge of the global economy and financial markets and bring that perspective to asset class research, strategic & tactical asset allocation, capital market assumptions, and portfolio construction. As an integral member of the Portfolio & Market Strategy division of the Investment Advisory Group, Eylem helps develop strategic and tactical asset allocation strategies driving the management of private and institutional clients. Eylem is a contributing author to the flagship Market Navigator monthly publication, and other related topical and market strategy communications. Eylem is also an adjunct faculty member at Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service, a position he has held since 2013.

Experience

Eylem joined Truist predecessor SunTrust in 2018 as the senior global macro strategist until 2023, where he was responsible for analyzing the global economies and financial markets, as well as helping formulate and communicate Truist's investment strategy. Eylem brings more than 22 years of investment experience to the Investment Advisory Group. Prior to working at Truist, he contributed to Global Fixed Income Investment Management team at T.Rowe Price. Before that, he worked as head of trading & investment manager at Ashmore Equities Investment Management, managing a team of traders trading global equites, related foreign exchange and derivative transactions.

He was a member of the firm's investment committee and helped managed about \$2.0 billion, serving as the investment manager overseeing the group's tactical portfolio investing in emerging market ETFs and listed equities. He began his career at Charles River, where he designed investment management applications and quantitative tools for asset liability management, hedging and investment strategy.











SYMBOLS OF THE BAY ATLANTIC UNIVERSITY



THE MACE

The origins of the mace can be traced to medieval times when knights carried them as weapons during processions with their kings. As the tradition grew, the mace became a symbol of authority and was often decorated with elaborate embellishments and gems. Today, an academic mace represents the authority invested in the president by a school's governing body and is used only on formal academic occasions, including Commencement, Convocation, and presidential inaugurations, when participants are in full regalia and the president is in attendance.

The new BAU mace bears the Coat of Arms on two sides, the acronym "BAU" on one side and the year 2014 (the year the university was established) on the other side.



CHAIN OF OFFICE

Accompanying the mace is the distinguished BAU chain of office, adorning the university president's academic regalia. Comprising interlinking circles inscribed with "BAU," the institution's charter year, the depiction of the coat of arms, and all the symbols on the coat of arms separately on each circle, this chain represents the trust and authority bestowed upon the president by the university's governing body.











During inaugural ceremonies, the chain is ceremoniously placed around the neck of the new president by the chair of the Board of Trustees, signifying the transfer of leadership and authority. The president then wears it during the commencement ceremony and convocations with the gown.



THE PRESIDENTIAL GOWN

The presidential gown features four velvet chevrons adorning each sleeve —an honor reserved for university presidents—and is trimmed in a braided buff silk cord. The wool costume is completed with a tam in matching blue velvet and a gold bullion tassel. The gown is reserved for academic convocations, commencement ceremonies, and other formal occasions, symbolizing the authority and dignity of the university presidency.



THE SEAL

Central to the university's identity is its official seal, a circular emblem featuring the institution's name, location in Washington, D.C., and the year of its founding encircling a coat of arms. This seal serves as a hallmark of authenticity and tradition, embossed on official documents and university correspondence.
